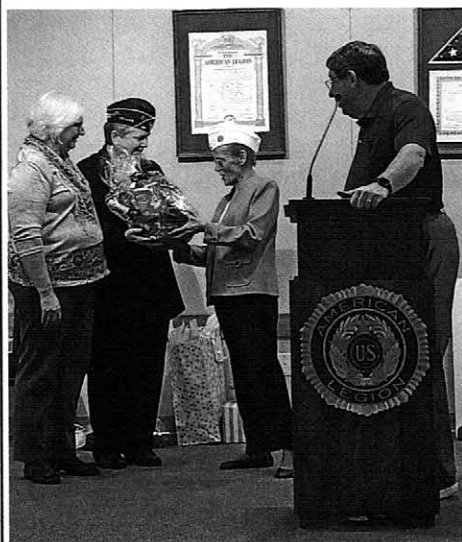
March is the last month you will receive a newsletter if you have
